STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

RESOLVE, Appropriating Funds to the Biddeford High School Band to Play at the Inauguration of the President of the United States at Washington, D. C.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, Acts and resolves of the Legislature do not become effective until go days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies: and

Whereas, the inauguration of the President of the United States will take place on January 20, 1977, in Washington, D.C.; and

Whereas, the Biddeford High School band has been selected to represent the State at the swearing-in ceremonies; and

Whereas, funds traditionally authorized by the Governor and Council are not available because of the abolishment of the Council, therefore, requiring a legislative appropriation; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore, be it

Biddeford High School; funds for. Resolved: That the sum of \$2,500 be appropriated from the General Fund to be paid to the Biddeford High School band to offset expenses of the school band playing at the presidential inauguration during the 18th, 19th, 20th and 21st of January 1977 in Washington. D.C.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
