COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 90, L.D. 116, RESOLVE,  
Authorizing the Bureau of Public Lands to Convey by Sale the  
State's Interest in Certain Real Property in Warren and Cushing,  
Knox County.

Amend the Resolve by inserting after the first sentence of  
the 2nd paragraph the following:

'The property shall be sold to the highest bidder except where  
the director determines there is good cause to do otherwise and  
except that the director may reject any and all bids.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require sale of the  
property to the highest bidder except where the director determines  
there is good cause to do otherwise and except that the director  
may reject any and all bids.
