HOUSE AMENDMENT "C" to H.P. 98, L.D. 122, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify Vocational Education Reimbursement in Vocational Centers and Vocational Regions."

Amend the bill by inserting at the end, before the emergency clause, the following:

'Sec. 6. Application. This Act shall not affect the distribution of school subsidies until July 1, 1978.'

Further amend the bill by striking out all of emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect July 1, 1977.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify that the Act will become effective for cost reporting purposes on July 1, 1977, but for subsidy distribution purposes, on July 1, 1978.
