COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 100, L.D. 124, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to School Age under the Education Laws."

Amend the Bill by inserting after section 1 the following:

'Sec. 2. 20 MRSA §859, as last amended by PL 1975, c. 746, §12-B,
is further amended by inserting after the 2nd paragraph the
following:

Notwithstanding the age requirements of this section, a pupil
who was enrolled in a public kindergarten or in grade 1 in another
state may be admitted to kindergarten or to grade 1, respectively,
in the administrative unitⁱⁿ which his parents or guardian establish
their residency. Also, notwithstanding the age requirements of
this section, a pupil who was enrolled in a public kindergarten
in another state and was promoted to grade 1 may be admitted
to grade 1 in the administrative unitⁱⁿ which his parents or
guardian establish their residency.'

Further amend the Bill by renumbering section 2 to be section
3.

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to permit administrative units
to admit students moving into this State to continue their education
regardless of the fact that their birth date may come after
October 15th of a given year.
