IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to School Age under the Education Laws.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 20 MRSA § 859, 2nd ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 212, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 20 MRSA § 859, 4th ¶, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 746, § 12-B, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this Act is to make the same age requirements apply to students coming into Maine as those who reside here. At the present time, incoming students have an advantage.
