Amend the Amendment by striking out all of the last underlined sentence before the Statement of Fact and inserting in its place the following:

'That power shall be granted only to local law enforcement officers who have completed a basic training course at the Maine Criminal Justice Academy or for whom the basic training course has been waived by the board of trustees of the academy because of equivalent training, as provided in section 2805, subsection 1.'

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the wording of the training requirement.
