IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Define Reasonable Compensation for Attorney Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

15 MRSA § 810, as last amended by P & SL 1975, c. 147, Part C, § 14, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

"Reasonable compensation" shall mean the following: \$10 per hour for investigative and interview work; \$20 per hour for legal research and \$30 per hour for actual trial work.

This bill defines what "reasonable compensation" for an attorney's services will amount to.
