STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Equalize Dog License Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 7 MRSA § 3451, 2nd ¶, 1st sentence, as amended by PL 1975, c. 391, § 1, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

A fee of \$5 shall be paid the city or town clerk for each license issued.

Sec. 2. 7 MRSA § 3451, 2nd ¶, 2nd and 3rd sentences, as amended, are repealed as follows:

All female dogs shall be considered capable of producing young unless a certificate issued by any licensed veterinarian, or any previous license record, is presented from a licensed veterinarian stating that such female was made incapable of bearing young by spaying by him. When such certificate accompanies the application, a fee of \$1.50 shall then be paid on such spayed females

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to provide for a uniform licensing fee of \$5 for all dogs. Previously, the fee was \$1.50 for male and spayed female dogs and \$5.50 for female dogs capable of bearing young.
