COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 124, L.D. 157, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Laws Relating to Payments for Care of Children."

Amend the Bill in subsection 1 by striking out all of paragraph B and inserting in its place the following:

'B. For residential child care facilities in an amount equal to, but not exceeding, 80% of audited unit cost and based on actual expenditures in the most recent fiscal year. The total amount paid from all sources shall not exceed 100% of actual cost.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment will allow the child care facilities to collect 100% of actual cost. There will be no additional cost to the State.
