HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 127, L.D. 160, Bill, "AN ACT
to Annex the Town of Otisfield to Oxford County."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2 and inserting
in its place the following:

'Sec. 2. Obligations to Cumberland County. The existing
bonded indebtedness of the Town of Otisfield to the County of
Cumberland shall be determined in a just and equitable manner by
the commissioners of Cumberland County and the selectmen of
Otisfield upon the effective date of this Act.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to restore the financial
obligation of the Town of Otisfield and further provide a fair
settlement by all parties involved.
