HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 136,
L.D. 169, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Application Fees for
Official Inspection Stations."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the 2nd
paragraph after the title and inserting in its place the
following:

'Sec. 1. 29 MRSA §2122, 3rd sentence is amended to read:
If, at the time of such inspection, the condition of said
vehicle conforms in each and every respect as required by
law and the rules and regulations governing inspection
promulgated by the Chief of the State Police, an official
inspection sticker as a certificate of inspection furnished
by the Chief of the State Police shall be placed in the
lower left-hand corner of the windshield or in the center
of the windshield back of the rear mirror, as the owner or
operator may prefer.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to give the owner or
operator of a vehicle the option of putting the inspection
sticker either in back of the mirror or in the corner of the
windshield.
