HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 147, L.D. 177, Bill, "AN ACT to Require that Savings from Substitution of Generic Drugs be Passed on to the Purchaser."

Amend the Bill by striking out in the 3rd line the word "sentence" and inserting in it place the word 'sentences'

Further amend the Bill by adding at the end, before the statement of fact, the following:

'The full amount of savings realized by this substitution shall be deemed passed on if the same percentage of mark up applied to the drug product originally prescribed is applied to the cost of the substituted drug product.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide that the full amount of savings realized by such substitution shall be deemed passed on if the same percentage of marl up applied to the cost of the substituted drug producty applied to the drug product originally prescribed.
