COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 148, L.D. 178, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Term of Membership on the Board of Visitors for Mental Health and Corrections' Institutions and the Baxter School for the Deaf."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'34 MRSA §41, 1st and 2nd sentences, as amended, are repealed, and the following enacted in their place:

A board of 5 visitors, as heretofore established, shall be appointed as follows for each state institution within the department for the Governor Baxter School within the Department of Educational and Cultural Services. Two members shall be appointed by the President of the Senate, 2 members shall be appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one member shall be appointed jointly by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives. The member who is appointed jointly shall serve as chairman. Each member of the board shall be appointed for a term of one year, except that each member shall continue to serve until his successor has been appointed/qualified. Each member shall be eligible for reappointment.' COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 148, L.D. 178 Page 2.

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to:

1. Provide for appointments to the Boards of Visitors by the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House; and

2. Assure that any member will serve until his successor has been appointed.
