AN ACT Relating to the Term of Membership on the Board of Visitors for Mental Health and Corrections' Institutions and the Baxter School for the Deaf.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

34 MRSA § 41, 2nd sentence is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

These visitors shall be appointed for a term of one year and shall continue in office until their successors have been appointed and qualified and they shall be eligible for reappointment.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to provide continuation in office of members of the Board of Visitors for Mental Health and Corrections' institutions and the Baxter School for the Deaf, until their successors are appointed in order to avoid any interruption of service.
