STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Adjustment of Retirement Allowance for Retirees of the State Police.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

5 **MRSA § 1121, sub-§ 1, ¶ C, 1st ¶**, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1975, c. 770, § 23, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentence:

The recipient of a retirement allowance under this section shall receive, on any or all future adjustments in salaries to active members of the State Police, such amount as will equal $\frac{1}{2}$ of the current annual salary paid to members of their respective grades at the time of retirement.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this bill is to require that all State Police retirees, both prior and subsequent to July 9, 1943, shall receive the same payment of benefits as active members.
