HOUSE AMENDMENT"A" to H.P. 205, L.D. 193, Bill, "AN ACT to Reduce the Uniform Property Tax by 1 1/4 Mills."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting the following in its place:

'AN ACT to Reduce the Uniform Property Tax by 1 Mill.'

Further amend the bill by striking out everthing after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'36 MRSA §451, sub-§2, 3rd sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 660, §5, is amended to read:

The uniform property tax rate shall be 13 mills for the period beginning July 1, 1976, and ending June 30, 1977, and \$2.5 11.5 mills thereafter for the period beginning July 1, 1977, and ending June 30, 1978.

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the uniform property tax rate from 12.5 mills to 11.5 mills.
