HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 205, L.D. 193, Bill, "AN ACT to Reduce the Uniform Property Tax by 1 1/4 Mills."

Amend the bill by striking out all of the title and inserting the following in its place:

'AN ACT to Reduce the Uniform Property Tax by 1 Mill.'

Further amend the bill by striking out everthing after the enacting clause and before the emergency clause and inserting in its place the following:

'36 MRSA §451, sub-§2, 3rd sentence, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 660, §5, is amended to read:
The uniform property tax rate shall be 13 mills for the period beginning July 1, 1976, and ending June 30, 1977, and ~~12.5~~ 11.5 mills ~~thereafter~~ for the period beginning July 1, 1977, and ending June 30, 1978.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment changes the uniform property tax rate from 12.5 mills to 11.5 mills.
