AN ACT to Amend the Ambulance Services Act.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 32 MRSA § 73, sub-§ 1, 1st sentence, as amended by PL 1975, c. 293, § 4, is further amended to read:

There shall be an advisory board to the Department of Human Services for licensure of ambulance services, vehicles and personnel, consisting of ~~10~~ 12 members appointed by the Governor.

Sec. 2. 32 MRSA § 73, sub-§ 1, 4th sentence, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 544, § 113, is amended to read:

One member shall be a representative of a recognized state safety association; one a representative of rescue units; one a representative of municipalities operating ambulance and rescue units; ~~one a representative and 3 shall be~~ **representatives** of the public.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to add 2 members to the advisory board. This will allow for needed input in a complex field, possibly with the addition of an attorney and a nurse.
