COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 89, L.D. 213, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to the Purchase of Insurance by the Maine Insurance Advisory
Board."

Amend the Bill by striking out in the 7th line (5th and 6th
lines in L.D.) the underlined words "to include vehicle, ocean
marine and aircraft" and inserting in their place the underlined
words 'in accord with the Maine Tort Claims Act, Title 14'
section 8116'

Statement of Fact

This amendment replaces a list of specific kinds of property
with a reference to the Maine Tort Claims Act. This change
will remove an inconsistency between the 2 laws.
