COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 94, L.D. 218, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Employee Workmen's Compensation Law."

Amend the Bill after the enacting clause by inserting at the beginning of the first line 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Industrial Accident Commission the sum of \$20,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
