COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to S.P. 95, L.D. 219, Bill, "AN ACT to Reorganize the System of Public Post-secondary Education in Maine."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 1. P&SL 1865, c. 532, §4-A, last sentence, as enacted by P&SL 1967, c. 229, §3, is amended to read:

The board of trustees shall appoint such advisory committees on behalf of the various campuses and such other advisory committees as may appear desirable.

Sec. 2. P&SL 1865, c. 532, §4-B, sub-§4, as enacted by P&SL 1967, c. 229, §3, is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read:

The administrative council shall elect annually one of its members to serve as chairman. The chairman shall present to the chancellor all recommendations from the heads of the campuses. The chancellor shall transmit all such recommendations to the board of trustees.'

## Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are:

1. To require the board of trustees to establish advisory committees for each campus to provide citizen recommendations to the university in order to promote better understanding of the university's problems and potentials; and

2. To strengthen the administrative council by providing that it elect a chairman and for the transmittal of the council's recommendations to the board of trustees.
