HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 214, L.D. 224, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify and Reform the
Laws Relating to County Law Enforcement."

Amend the Amendment by striking out all of that part
designated "§1127." and inserting in its place the following:

'§1127. Ambulance Service

1. Scope of service. Each county may provide
ambulance service:

A. To the entire county, omitting only those municipalities
who request not to be included; or

B. By municipal-county contracts under section 63
or chapter 203, to those municipalities who enter into
contracts, provided county tax revenues are not used
to support the ambulance services.

2. Method of service. Within the limits of subsection 1,
the county may provide ambulance services by county personnel
and vehicles or by contract with private organizations,
corporations or persons, or with municipalities under section
63 or chapter 203.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment allows counties to provide the ambulance
service to the entire county, omitting only municipalities

that request to be omitted, or to provide the service by contract with municipalities but without using county tax revenues.
