HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to H.P. 214, L.D. 224, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify and Reform the Laws Relating to County Law Enforcement."

Amend the bill in section 4 in that part designated "§951." in the first paragraph by inserting after the first sentence the following:

'If the county commissioners or the county personnel board withhold approval of a proposed deputy sheriff, they shall, within 14 days after the sheriff has submitted the name of the proposed deputy sheriff to them, notify the sheriff in writing of the reasons for their disapproval.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment concerns the requirement that the county commissioners or county personnel board must approve each appointed full-time or part-time deputy under Title 30, section

951. The amendment requires that if the county commissioners or county personnel board withhold approval of a deputy, they must notify the sheriff in writing of their reasons for withholding approval.
