AN ACT Relating to Conduct of Examinations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

24-A MRSA § 1523, sub-§ 2, as amended by PL 1973, c. 585, § 12, is further amended to read:

2. The superintendent shall make examinations available to applicants ~~at least biweekly at the superintendent's principal office; and~~ at such other times and places in this State as the superintendent may deem advisable.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill, if enacted, will provide the Superintendent of Insurance with discretionary authority to deal flexibly with the frequency of insurance license examinations, thus reducing costs if reduced frequency of examinations is feasible.
