AN ACT Concerning the Power of the Criminal Justice Academy to Inspect Records to Ensure Compliance with Law Enforcement Officer Employment Requirements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

25 MRSA § 2805, sub-§ 4, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 672, § 3, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

The academy board of trustees shall have the power and duty to inspect payroll and other records of each political subdivision to ascertain the information described in this section.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to give the academy board of trustees the stand-by power and duty to inspect payroll and other records of any local law enforcement agency to ensure compliance with the mandatory reporting section regarding employment of local law enforcement officers.
