COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 104, L.D. 233, Bill,
"AN ACT to Allocate Moneys for the Administrative Expenses
of the Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages, Department of Finance
and Administration and the State Liquor Commission for the
Fiscal Years Ending June 30, 1978 and June 30, 1979."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of section 5 and inserting in its place the following:

'Sec. 5. Exclusion. Exclusive of sections 1 through 4, up to \$20,000 for capital expenditures may be expended in each year of the 1977-1979 biennium.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reduce the amount of capital expenditures under the bill from \$50,000 to \$20,000 for each year of the biennium.
