SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 185, L.D. 247, Bill,
"AN ACT to Provide Minimum Subsidy Payments for Small
Administrative Units."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the
Emergency clause the following:

'Sec. 11. Appropriation. There is appropriated to
the Department of Educational and Cultural Services from
for the fiscal year 1977-78
the General Fund the sum of \$106,000/to carry out the
purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
