HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 186,
L.D. 248, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing the Pay for Substitute Teachers."

Amend the amendment by striking out the last paragraph
before the statement of fact and inserting in its place the following:

'Any money paid by a school administrative unit as a premium
for an annuity contract for the benefit of an employee shall be
considered part of such employee's salary.'

The purpose of this amendment is to remove unnecessary
reference to minimum salaries for teachers from the committee
amendment.
