COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 186, L.D. 248, Bill,
"AN ACT Increasing the Pay for Substitute Teachers."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the Title and
inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT Relating to Minimum Salaries for Teachers.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in its place the
following:

'20 MRSA §1901, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 571,
§39, is repealed.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the existing statute
which presently provides for the following:

1. Minimum salaries for teachers;
2. A rate of compensation for substitute teachers;
3. Authority for the commissioner to adjust allocations
to local units upon a showing that the unit manipulated
expenditures "to gain unfair advantage;" and
4. Requirement that money paid by the unit for an
annuity contract for an employee should be included as part
of the minimum salary.
