HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 186, L.D. 248, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing the Pay for Substitute Teachers."

Amend the Bill by strikingout everything after the enacting clause and inserting in its place the following:

'20 MRSA §1901, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 571, §39, is repealed and the following enacted in its place: \$1901. Substitute teachers

Substitute teachers with 4 years of study beyond the high school and with a bachelor's degree and in possession of a standard teachers' certificate and substitute teachers who have retired after a minimum of 15 years of teaching shall be compensated at the rate of not less than \$25 for each day of service.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish the pay for substitute teachers at a rate of not less than \$25 for each day of service.
