SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 187,
L.D. 249, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Presidential Primary in
the State of Maine."

Amend the amendment by striking out in the 6th line the underlined
words "first Tuesday in March" and inserting in their place the
underlined words '2nd Tuesday of June'

Further amend the Amendment by inserting at the end before
the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the Bill by striking out all of that part designated
"§478," and inserting in its place the following:

§478. Selection of delegates

Delegates to national presidential nominating conventions shall
be selected by the state parties meeting in convention at any time
after the presidential primary in accordance with chapter 13.

The method and procedures for selection of delegates shall be
according to reasonable procedures established by the state party
convention.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish that the presidential
primary election be held on the 2nd Tuesday of June of each primary
election year. The amendment also deletes from the bill the limitations
the method and procedures for selection of delegates to national
presidential nominating conventions.
