SENATE AMENDMENT"C"to HOUSE AMENDMENT"A" to H.P. 187, L.D. 249, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Presidential Primary in the State of Maine."

Amend the amendment by striking out all of the first 3 paragraphs and inserting in their place the following:

'Amend the bill in that part designated "§471." by striking out all of subsections 1 and 2 and inserting in their place the following:

'1. Presidential primary election held. The State of
Maine shall hold a presidential primary election, which
election shall be held on the 2nd Tuesday in June each year
when a President of the United States is elected.'

Further amend the amendment by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Further amend the bill by striking out all of that part designated "§478." and inserting in its place the following:
'§478. Selection of delegates

Delegates to national presidential nominating conventions shall be selected by the state parties meeting in convention.

The method and procedures for selection of delegates shall be according to procedures established by the state party convention.''

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish that the presidential primary election be held on the 2nd Tuesday of June of each primary election year. The amendment also deletes from the bill the limitations in the method and procedures for selection of delegates to national presidential nominating conventions.
