HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 187, L.D. 249, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Presidential Primary in the State of Maine."

Amend the bill in that part designated "§471." by striking out all of subsections 1 and 2 and inserting in their place the following:

'1. Presidential primary election held. The State of Maine shall hold a presidential primary election, which election shall be held on the first Tuesday in March each year when a president of the United States is elected.

2. Secretary of State sets date. The Secretary of State shall determine the date of the Maine presidential primary election and announce that date at least 120 days in advance of the date for the primary election.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to establish a presidential election primary/in the State of Maine exclusive of any other state's presidential primary election.
