HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H.P. 187, L.D. 249, Bill, "AN
ACT to Establish a Presidential Primary in the State of Maine."

Amend the Bill in that part designated "§472." by
striking out all of subsection 1 and by renumbering subsections
2 and 3 to be subsections 1 and 2.

Further amend the Bill in that part designated "§475."
in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraphs A, B and C
and inserting in their place the following:

'A. Persons who the Secretary of State determines should be
placed on the ballot in accordance with this section may
have their names withdrawn from the ballot by filing with the
Secretary of State an affidavit by which the person designated
swears under oath that the person requests that his name
be omitted from the ballot.

In order to remove a person's name from the ballot, the
affidavit shall be received by the Secretary of State at
least 45 days prior to the date designated for the presidential
primary election.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for placement of names on the ballot
by petition.
