# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

#### AN ACT to Transfer Regulations Regarding the Security of Certain Parks, Grounds, Buildings and Appurtenances Maintained by the State from the Department of Finance and Administration to the Department of Public Safety.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 5 MRSA § 1742-A, as enacted by PL 1971, c. 622, § 17-B, is repealed.

Sec. 2. 5 MRSA §§ 1771 - 1776, as amended, are repealed.

Sec. 3. 25 MRSA § 2903 is enacted to read:

§ 2903. Bureau of Capital Security

The Commissioner of Public Safety is authorized and empowered to promugate regulations, subject to the approval of the Governor, governing the use, occupancy and security of all parks, grounds, buildings and appurtenances maintained by the State at the seat of government. These regulations shall become effective upon deposit of a copy with the Secretary of State, who shall forward a copy attested under the Great Seal of the State to the District Court for Southern Kennebec.

Sec. 4. Appropriation. There is transferred from the Department of Finance and Administration to the Department of Public Safety the sum of \$300,000 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:
