IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT Relating to Use of Flashing Red Lights on School Buses when Negotiating Turn Arounds on Public Ways.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 29 MRSA § 2019, sub-§ 4, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 510, § 41, is amended to read:
- 4. Use of flashing red lights restricted. A school bus operator shall not use the system of red flashing lights on a school bus for any purpose other than controlling traffic in connection with the stopping of such a bus for the purpose of receiving or discharging school children and when negotiating a turn around on a public way.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The prupose of this bill is to amend Title 29, section 2019, subsection 4, by adding the following phrase at the end . . . "and when negotiating a turn around on a public way."
