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**AN ACT Relating to Use of Flashing Red Lights on School Buses when  
Negotiating Turn Arounds on Public Ways.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

29 MRSA § 2019, sub-§ 4, as enacted by PL 1975, c. 510, § 41, is amended to read:

4. **Use of flashing red lights restricted.** A school bus operator shall not use the system of red flashing lights on a school bus for any purpose other than controlling traffic in connection with the stopping of such a bus for the purpose of receiving or discharging school children **and when negotiating a turn around on a public way.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to amend Title 29, section 2019, subsection 4, by adding the following phrase at the end . . . "and when negotiating a turn around on a public way."
