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**RESOLVE, Providing Funds for Clients in Special Age Groups Served by  
Cerebral Palsy Centers.**

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**Cerebral Palsy Centers; appropriation. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Cerebral Palsy Centers in Maine the sum of \$40,000 for the biennium to be used to help support a program of infant services, extended adult services, prevocational services, diagnostic and evaluation services and therapy services for clients ages 0-4 and ages 21 and over who are not covered by existing laws. The breakdown shall be as follows:
