COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 221, L.D. 285, Bill,  
"AN ACT to Increase Flexibility in the Funding and Operation  
of the Vocational-Technical Institutes."

Amend the Bill ← → at the beginning of the first  
line after the enacting clause by striking out the underlined  
abbreviation and figure "Sec. 1."

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated  
"§2363." by striking out all of subsection 1 and inserting in  
its place the following:

'1. Definition. All vocational-technical institute  
tuition revenue and all donations or monetary gifts received  
by the vocational-technical institutes shall be credited by the  
Treasurer of State to a special, nonlapsing Maine Vocational-  
Technical Institute Fund. '

Further amend the Bill in section 1 in that part designated  
"§2363." in subsection 2 by striking out all of paragraph C  
and inserting in its place the following:

'C. To expend public or private donations or gifts  
specifically donated, or given, to the institute to fund  
an identified project in accordance with the plan for  
the project as submitted by the institute to the state  
of Education  
board/and as approved by the ← → board.'

Further amend the Bill in section 1 by striking out all  
of that part designated "§2365." and inserting in its place the  
following:

'§2365. Allocation of faculty and administrative positions at the vocational-technical institutes; unclassified status  
The department, consistant with legislative authorization, shall allocate the faculty and administrative positions, as identified pursuant to section 2364, between the several vocational-technical institutes and the school of practical nursing in Waterville. The department shall notify the Bureau of the Budget of the allocation of these positions.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out all of section 2.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to allow all tuition receipts to be placed in the nonlapsing Maine Vocational-Technical Institute Fund and to continue the present governance of the State Board of Education over the vocational-technical institutes.
