STATE OF MAINE SENATE 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 223, L.D. 287, Bill, "AN ACT to Regulate the Circulating of Initiative or Referendum Petitions."

Amend the Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'4. Prohibited acts at polling places. It shall be unlawful for any person to solicit donations, gifts, contributions purchase of tickets, or similar demands, or to request or obtain signatures on petitions in the polling room or any interior compartment of the building therewith connected.'

Statement of Fact

The intent of this amendment is to revise the original bill in order to meet all constitutional requirements and to limit prohibited acts to the polling room or any interior compartment of the building connected therewith.
