IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Regulate the Circulating of Initiative or Referendum Petitions.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

21 MRSA § 892, sub-§ 4 is enacted to read:

4. **Circulating of or obtaining signatures on initiative or referendum petitions. A person shall not circulate or obtain signatures on initiative or referendum petitions within 250 feet of the polling place.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to regulate the distance persons can circulate initiative or referendum petitions at the polls.
