COMMITTEE OF CONFERENCE AMENDMENT " A" to H.P. 229,
L.D. 292, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Powers and Duties of
the Maine Committee on Aging."

Amend the Bill in section 2 in the 10th line (7th
line in L.D.) by striking out the underlined words and
punctuation "liability, civil or criminal," and inserting
in their place the underlined words 'criminal liability'

Further amend the Bill in section 2 in the 12th line
(9th line in L.D) by striking out the underlined words and
punctuation "proceedings, civil or criminal," and inserting
in their place the underlined words 'criminal proceedings'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove immunity
from civil liability from the bill, but to retain immunity
from criminal liability.
