COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 230, L.D. 293, Bill,
"AN ACT to Ensure that the Powers and Duties of Fire Chiefs
are subject to Municipal Collective Bargaining Agreements."

Amend the Bill by striking out all of the Title and
inserting in its place the following:

'AN ACT Relating to the Powers and Duties of Fire Chiefs.'

Further amend the Bill by striking out everything after
the amending clause and inserting in its place the following:

'This subsection does not limit those matters which are
properly subject to collective bargaining by a municipality
under Title 26, chapter 9-A.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is:

1. To amend a misleading title; and
2. To ensure . . . the fact that Title 30, section 3773, which
lists certain powers and duties of fire chiefs, does not limit
the matters that can be subject to collective bargaining.
