STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-SEVEN

AN ACT to Ensure that the Powers and Duties of Fire Chiefs are subject to Municipal Collective Bargaining Agreements.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 3773, sub-§ 2, as enacted by PL 1973, c. 680, § 5, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

The powers and duties set forth in this subsection shall be subject to preemption by a collective bargaining agreement entered into by that municipality pursuant to Title 26, chapter 9-A.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that the powers and duties of a municipal fire chief set forth by 30 MRSA § 3773 shall be subject to a collective bargaining agreement entered into by a municipality under the Municipal Public Employees Labor Relations Law. Obviously, the Legislature did not intend 30 MRSA § 3773 to negate collective bargaining agreements throughout the State.
