RESOLVE, to Provide for the Purchase of Copies of "A History of the Town of Hollis" by Olive Hannaford and Martin Jewitt.

Historl of Hollis; purchase of copies. RESOLVED: That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$600 to purchase 50 copies of "A History of the Town of Hollis" by Olive Hannaford and Martin Jewitt. These books may be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this resolve is to allow the purchase of 50 copies of "A History of the Town of Hollis" by Olive Hannaford and Martin Jewitt at a price of \$12 per copy. It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage the publication of books dealing with the history of towns in Maine and thus preserving the history of the State.
