These books may be exchanged or distributed at the discretion of the State Librarian.

The purpose of this resolve is to allow the purchase of 100 copies of "Acadian and Van Buren History" by Martine Pelletier and Monica Perritti at a price of \$6 per copy. It has been the practice of the Legislature to encourage the publication of books dealing with the history of towns in Maine and thus preserving the history of the State.
