COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 236, L.D. 299, Bill, "AN ACT to Improve the Viability and Efficiency of Local Conservation Commissions."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the end of section 1 the following underlined sentences:

'Any commissioner presently serving a term greater than 3 years may serve until his term expires. The appointment of his successor shall be for a term of 3 years.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that present conservation commissioners may continue in office until the expiration of their terms.
