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**AN ACT to Establish the Salary Level for the Superintendent of the Bureau of Consumer Protection.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

2 MRSA § 6, sub-§ 2, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 585, § 11, is repealed and the following enacted in its place:

2. The salaries of the following state officials and employees to no more than \$24,000:

**Bank Superintendent;**

**Bureau of Consumer Protection Superintendent;**

**State Tax Assessor.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is as follows:

The enactment of the Maine Consumer Credit Code created the Bureau of Consumer Protection effective January 1, 1975. While the position of the superintendent of the bureau is unclassified, it has not been included in the listing of salary levels in Title 2, section 6. The enactment of this bill would place the salary of the superintendent on the same level as the Superintendent of the Bureau of Banks and Banking.
