## STATE OF MAINE SENATE 108TH LEGISLATURE FIRST REGULAR SESSION

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 130, L.D. 310, Bill, "AN ACT to Transfer the Alcohol Treatment and Education Program of Operating under the Influence Offenders to the Department of Human Services."

Amend the Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and tigure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend the Bill by inserting at the end before the statement of fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Transitional provision. It is the intent of the Legislature that all employees presently assigned to the alcohol treatment and education program operated under the auspices of the Secretary of State be transferred with the program to the Department of Human Services. Such employees shall retain their classified status, subject to the Personnel Law, unless they voluntarily relinquish it and shall be transferred without loss of sick leave, vacation pay, other benefits and seniority.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to assure that all employees of State of the program conducted by the Secretary/are able to transfer to the Department of Human Services.
