SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 244, L.D. 318, Bill, "AN ACT  
Concerning the Administration of Property Tax Laws Administered  
by the Bureau of Taxation."

Amend the bill by striking out all of sections 6 and 7;  
and by renumbering the sections to read consecutively.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prevent the repeal of  
what was sometimes referred to as the "Chase Law." These sections  
established the policy for forest land assessments, prior to the  
current Tree Growth Tax Law.
